

For purposes of accurate advising, keep your **degree and major** updated through your advisor in FSAC, 126 Strong Hall, or CLAS Undergraduate Services, 109 Strong Hall.

The ARTS form reflects your three most recent **test results** (2-ACT, 2-SAT). KU uses these scores in determining your initial placement in Math and English courses.

Make sure the university has your current address. Update at the Registrar's Office, 121 Strong Hall, or online at http://www.registrar.ku.edu/online/address_updatenew.shtml

Total hours required is the minimum number of hours a student must have to graduate. Total hours completed should equal the number of transfer hours (graded A-C) plus the number of KU (A-D) hours. Currently enrolled courses are **not** included in the calculation. **Beginning Fall 2003, students are required to complete 45 Junior/Senior hours.**

English: Must enroll the 1st semester at KU in English composition course according to placement and must continue to take English courses until completion of ENGL 102/105 (honors). **Oral Communication/Logic:** Two high school courses (totaling one full credit) in speech or debate with a grade of "B" or better in both may exempt you from this requirement. Take a copy of your transcript to Communication Studies department in Bailey Hall. **Math:** By the 2nd semester in CLAS, students must enroll in math course according to placement and continue taking math courses until MATH 101 or MATH 104 has been completed. Refer to ACT, SAT, or math placement test scores for appropriate placement in initial math course.

Your **KU GPA** reflects only those courses taken at KU (it may exclude grades earned through KU Continuing Education). Your academic standing (for example, honor roll and/or probation designation) is determined by your **KU GPA**.

Be aware of the **maximum and add-on hour requirements** for courses from community colleges, physical education, music, correspondence, military science, and remedial. Hours will be added to the total number required to graduate (124) if you exceed the maximum hours allowed.

If you have transfer credit or advanced placement that is **not** appearing on your ARTS form, notify your academic advisor. Official transcripts from the institution awarding credit must be submitted to the Office of Admissions and Scholarships for evaluation.

Note the differences in requirements between the two degrees, BA and BGS. Your Principal Course requirements vary in number depending on your degree. Discuss this with your advisor. In addition, you may be required to complete a foreign language or a junior-senior concentration/minor depending on the degree you choose.
